Rodeo Grounds:

Barbara Johnson We have play days for July August and September. We have them so they will help bring in business hopefully for the farmers market as well. For the grants we are waiting for the leach fields to be marked out and meaning it's for a grant I'm thinking we will ask for a whole new system. If we add more bathrooms we may need to update the system.

Glenella: I believe its a fairly new system. They use to back up but they don't now because Carl Shumway fixed that when he was on the board here. The plumbing in the Food Shack is all underground and has busted. Carl will be the person that has the most information on the system Do you have a plan on paper like blueprints?

Barbara Johnson: I'm waiting on the information on the leach fields. I have to know so I know where to put parking.

Glenella: How does the leach field information make you go one way or the other

Barbara Johnson: Well the leach field is based on the size of the Septic system, If we are trying to add bathrooms either the kitchen or out at the stalls, if the system is not big enough we are going to have to put in a bigger system and more leach. Along the north wall we want to put in a wall and a dance floor. I can't figure the size until I know where the leach field is.

David Uran: I have a question. Is that leach field going to accommodate a future RV site like it used to.

Glenella: It was already designed to handle 5 RV spots and currently there is 3. We need to block off that road out there so there is no drive thru.

Barbara Johnson: If we put bathrooms out at the stalls we can run the leach field out there.

Chuck Carroll: There is times when in the Community there is a need for RV parking

Barbara Johnson: How many total RV spots do you want?

Rena Dunne: What about dry camp? People are wanting more dump sites too.

Glenella: I don't think a Dump site is a good idea. You know what a baby wipe looks like when you clean it out of a system?

Barbara Johnson: Are we still getting telephone poles?

Shara: Yes we are on the list however, we have to go to La Pine to pick them up. They will be cut into either 8 or 10 feet. All we have to do is call. Shara will text number to Barbara Johnson for Mid-state

Barbara Johnson: Meaning someone is playing with cars in the arena can park and rec put chains and locks on the gates? Keys. Is it possible to get keys to the rodeo grounds. That way we don't have to call Lisa? The panels have been moved for easy to mow entrance.

Glenna: Disc Lisa has one for sale for \$150.00 need someone to go and look at it.

Barbara Johnson: Yes we can use that disc

Glenna: I have a box of combo locks and we are getting away from keys. I will go by there today and put a lock on the power.

Rena Dunne: When I had the farmers Market the lights was on. Has the Arena been tilled?

Barbara Johnson: I would love to burn over there.

Glenna: Yeah well there is a no burn. There is equipment at the shop that belongs to the rodeo out there just go get it.

Farmers Market: Rena turned in \$50.00 for table rent.
